Effective October 1, 2024, claims for genetic testing services during pregnancy will require a prior authorization if the code is listed as requiring this in the Prior Authorization Lookup Tool. The listings within the tool have not changed. However, due to a system limitation, some claims may have been processing without prior authorization.

We will be removing an exception from the Prior Authorization Guide indicating that prior authorization for genetic tests following amniocentesis will be exempt from prior authorization. This is a reminder to check authorization requirements in the Prior Authorization Tool and request authorization accordingly.
