Informational Bulletin Regarding Emergency Declaration – Palisades Fire and Windstorm Conditions

This is an advisory notification to Molina Healthcare of California (MHC) network providers applicable to all lines of business.

What you need to know:

Governor Gavin Newsom declared a state of emergency in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties on January 7, 2025, due to the Palisades Fire and windstorm conditions.

On January 7, 2025, the Palisades Fire ignited in Los Angeles County, burning over 1,200 acres as of the time this Proclamation is issued; and high winds, low humidity, and dry conditions have increased the intensity and spread of the Palisades Fire, causing imminent threat to life with Red Flag warnings in effect in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties and widespread dangerous windstorm conditions with damaging wind gusts of 50 to 80 mph forecasted.
