Informational Bulletin Regarding Emergency Declaration – Fast-Track Critical Wildfire Prevention Projects Statewide

This is an advisory notification to Molina Healthcare of California (MHC) network providers applicable to all lines of business.

What you need to know:

On March 1, 2025, Governor Newsom proclaimed a state of emergency to fast-track critical forest management projects, part of the state's ongoing efforts to protect communities from catastrophic wildfires.
