

Molina Adjusts Prior Authorization Requirements to Comply with Senate Bill 412

In accordance with Michigan Senate Bill 412, Molina Healthcare of Michigan (MHM) has updated prior authorization requirements for our Medicaid health plan for the following four categories:

- Cancer
- Organ replacement therapy
- Epilepsy or seizure disorder
- Opioid withdrawal

All authorization adjustments are effective as of June 8, 2022. MHM will reprocess claims from June 8 forward that may have been denied for authorization once our system updates are completed. Authorization requirements may be specific to particular diagnoses. Full updated MHM prior authorization matrices for the second and third quarters of 2022 are available at

For claims received for the noted categories, Molina will review and approve in accordance with reasonable, appropriate payment parameters (e.g., age, diagnosis, amounts, etc.) that align with a drug's United States Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) approved labeled indications.
