What is a High-Risk Pregnancy?

A pregnancy is high-risk if you or your baby has a higher chance of a health problem.

Many factors can cause a high-risk pregnancy.

- You have a health condition:
 - Diabetes
 - Cancer
 - High blood pressure
 - Kidney disease
 - Epilepsy
- You use drugs or alcohol.
- You are younger than 17 or older than 35.
- You are pregnant with more than one baby.
- You have had three or more miscarriages.
- You have had problems with past pregnancies.
- You have an infection, like hepatitis C or HIV.
