Dental Provider

Call your dentist day or night. After hours, on-call staff will return your call.

When you have a minor issue that requires medical care:

- Routine and regular dental care
- Toothache or chipped tooth
- Orthodontic procedures for nonemergent issues
- Teeth pulling
- Cosmetic dental procedures



Urgent Dental Care

Urgent care centers are a great option if you need care after hours.

When it's not an emergency but you need care right away:

- Severe dental pain
- Broken teeth
- Dental treatment required before medical procedures
- Denture adjustments or repairs



Cosmetic Dental Procedures

If you've had a procedure by an oral surgeon.

Contact your dental provider or specialist for:

 Additional surgical post operative care



Dental Emergencies

Call **911** or go to the nearest ER.

When you think your life or health is in danger:

- Bleeding that won't stop
- Infection with swelling on the inside or outside of the mouth
- Head trauma or trauma of facial bones that may effect airways
