Summary:

Preexposure Prophylaxis or PrEP is a form of antiretroviral therapy that is used for patients who are at risk of developing HIV. Only about 20% of people in Michigan who are at risk of becoming infected with HIV are currently on PrEP. Many providers are unaware of the broad array of patients at risk of developing HIV who would benefit from PrEP. Evidence shows that many patients on PrEP initiate the conversation with their provider themselves. There are great resources available to assist providers with PrEP and to help uninsured patients to cover their PrEP.
