## STIMULANT USE DISORDER ECHO

The goal of Project ECHO is to increase health care capacity by democratizing knowledge and to strengthen the capacity among primary care providers. This program aims to support healthcare and mental health providers, staff, and administrators with Stimulant Use Disorder patient care. Sessions will be facilitated with a team from Northern Nevada HOPES and will provide a forum to discuss patient cases, address questions/concerns, and collaborate regarding Stimulant Use Disorder therapy. The Subject Matter expert team for this series includes: a psychiatrist specializing in addiction, a licensed clinical social worker, a board certified family medicine and addiction physician, peer support specialist, and MAT Program Coordinator.
